Members Profile

Classic car celebrates 90th

Wes Hartley with the loves of his life - wife Beverley Biggs and Bj, the 1928 Ford Model A he named after her.



Owning a vintage car is a labour of love and something 'you can't put a price on', according to 1928 Ford Model A owner Wes Hartley.

Mr. Hartley has had his beloved, Bj, for the last ten years.

It is named after his wife Beverley, who has a fairly accurate way to describe Mr. Hartley's relationship with the car.

"She says 'it is the 90-year-old mistress that I allow you to have," Mr. Hartley laughed.

This year is the 90th anniversary of the release of the Ford Model A.

To mark the milestone, Mr. Hartley will venture to South Australia to participate in the Bay to Birdwood.

The annual historic motoring event will feature vehicles manufactured up to December 1959 and expects to attract more than 1000 vehicles. Up to 70,000 spectators will line the streets of Adelaide to watch the cavalcade of history pass by.

The Model As will have a special display in commemoration.

Mr. Hartley's prized possession will also be entered in the Concourse D'Elegance, which means his vehicle is of high quality and he will be dressing up in attire from the era of the car. He is also joining other Model A owners on a wider tour in Horsham.

Around 4.5 million Model A's were built and there are about 350,000 still in existence. Their condition ranges from pristine to utter decay.

Mr. Hartley has dreamed of owning a Model A since his youth.

"Those that know me know it is a passion of my life," he said.

"I've always had interest in vintage cars and veteran cars and when approaching retirement I thought it was something I would like to get involved in."

Ironically, prior to being purchased by Mr Hartley, Bj had a history with Busselton.

Bj's was owned by Bill Spencer, who retired in Busselton and set up a workshop in the light industrial area.

When he suddenly died, there was a clearance auction, which included his three Model As.

"My father-in-law bid on one of the cars but it went too high," he said.

"This car went all over WA and eventually I found it in Adelaide.

"As soon as I got back to Busselton, people said 'that's Daisy Duck, Bill Spencer's car'. So it is very funny that after 35 years away the car reappears in Busselton."

During her latest stint in Busselton, Bj has escorted the Festival of Busselton Queens and

appeared in Busselton Motorfest.

She cruises at 80 kilometres an hour and will run as long as there is petrol in her tank.

Even though she isn't the most fuel efficient choice, Mr. Hartley prefers his classic car to the 'toys' on the market today.

"With a vintage car, it is about the enjoyment in the journey, not necessarily getting to a destination," he said.






